

SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAN IN NAGALAND

Shri P B Acharya, Hon'ble Governor of Nagaland officially launched Swachh Bharat Abhiyan Campaign on 23rd March 2015 at Kohima. He insisted that all have to be soldier and participant in the whole mission also called for community participation to achieve the goal. He emphasised that every household in the villages should have toilets system also around bazaars, bus stations and other public places. Hon'ble Governor also appealed to the public to minimize the use of plastics.
