GOVERNOR VISITS JAIL

Hon'ble Governor Shri P.B.Acharya visited the District Jail Kohima today and interacted with the prisoners and jail officials, including the Chief Judicial Magistrate and Government Advocate. Governor observed that there are 92 under-trials and only three convicts. Some of them are under-trials for more than two years. Accordingly, Governor directed that the CJM and Government Advocate and government advocates to think of expediting their trial and dispose off the cases without delay. He also insisted that nobody should be in prison as Under-trial for more than six months and also briefed the Jailor to organise some welfare programmes and interaction with the society for the prisoners. Governor said that our aim should be bring these people in the mainstream and we should not push them to become hardcore criminals by delaying justice.
