

Governor interacts with civil societies



Governor P.B Acharya on Wednesday held a separate meeting with various civil societies including Nerhema Students Union (NSU) and Naga Blind Association Dimapur (NBAD) at Raj Bhavan this afternoon, the 19th August, 2015.

According to DIPR report, while hosting tea for the Nagaland Senior Citizens Association (NSCA), the governor assured to assist them for improvement of infrastructure of the association's office at Old Secretariat.

He also called a meeting with the chief engineers of housing and power departments at his office to urge the concerned departments to do the needful to make the NSCA office become functional within a month's time.

The governor also urged the senior citizens representatives to form a federal body with the participation of the senior citizens of the State so that they can also participate in the development of the state.

While interacting with NSU representatives, the governor assured to provide them three public toilets through people to people programme by Mumbai Rotary Club who has assured Rs 60 lakhs for the same.

NBAD, a voluntary organisation running a vocational training school established in the year 2001 for visually impaired person along with hostel facilities for both boys and girls at Dimapur, appraised their problems and grievances and submitted a memorandum for financial assistance for repair and renovation of the hostel.

The Governor assured them that he would forward the matter to the government for assistance and he would also come forward and help the institution as they are doing a noble job for the service of mankind.
